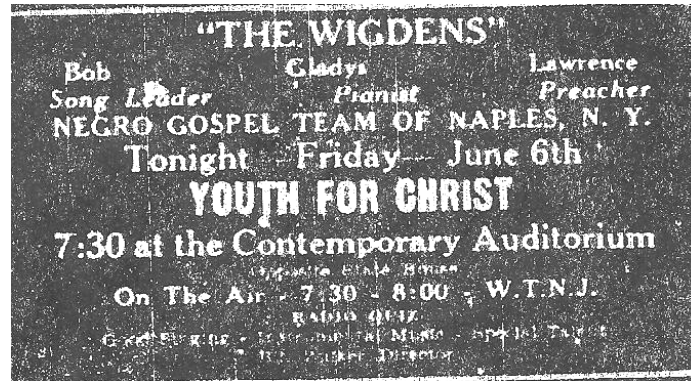


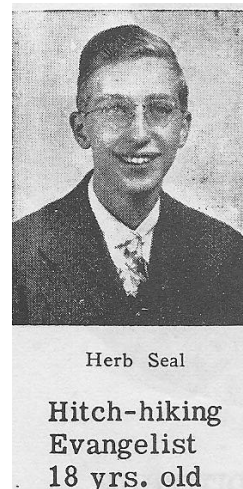


Bob Wigden and Bill Zulker at Naples, NY – January 1946

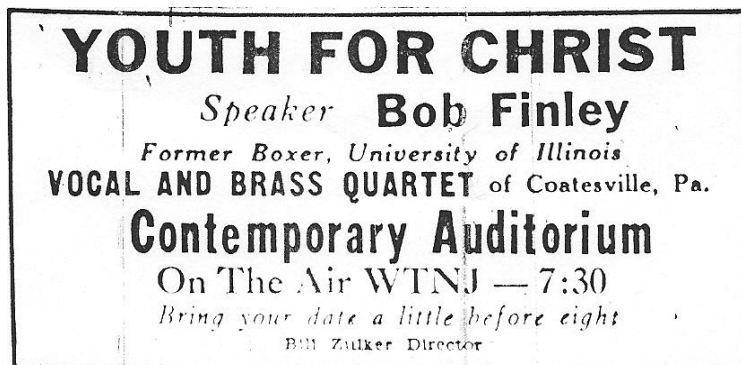

July 4, 1947 – Glenn Wagner, Pocket Testament League

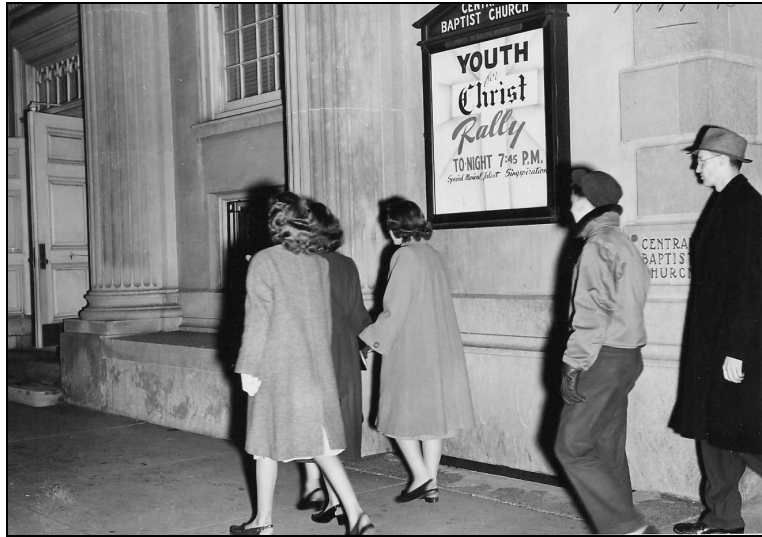
July 27, 1947 – Bob Finley, Former Boxer, University of Illinois

Bob and Billy Graham were the first "field evangelists" with Youth For Christ 1945-1947. He became a missionary in China in 1948, then Korea, Japan, Taiwan, the Philippines and India. In 1952 he became the founder of Christian Aid, a mission to finance indigenous ministries.

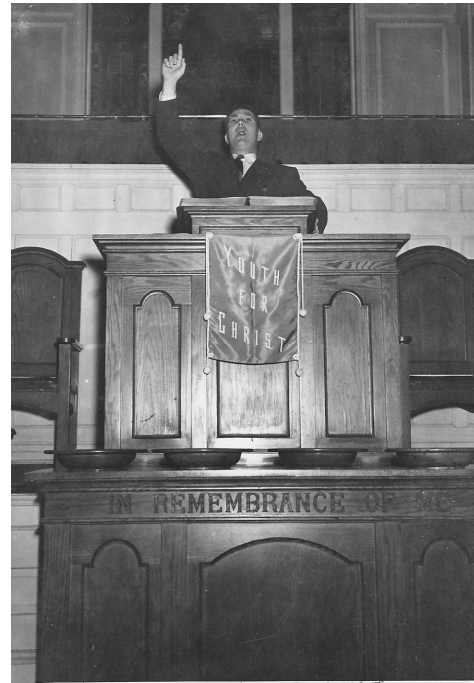
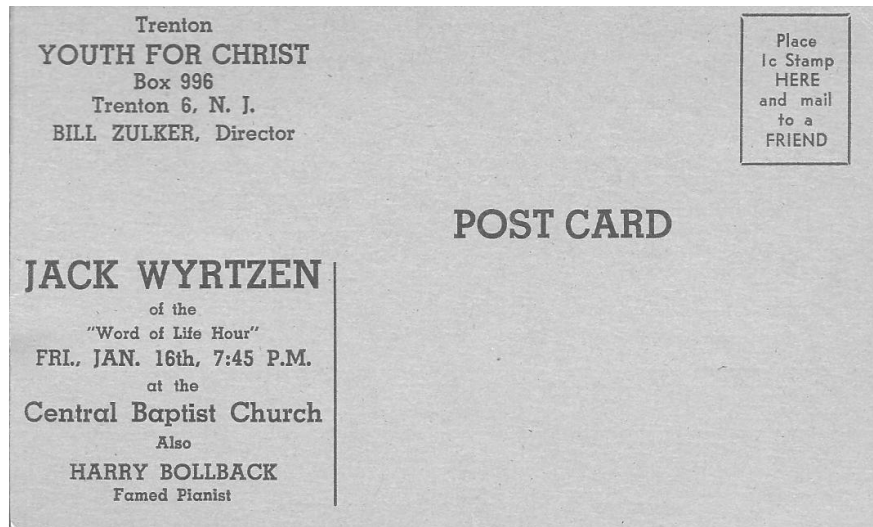
