- The East Petersburg a cappella Male Chorus presented a sacred concert in the Fontana Chapel, Fontana.
- Cleona teenagers attended a Hobo Party and Dance at the “little red schoolhouse” with Dennis Corcoran named best dressed hobo by the PTA.
- The Cornwall Methodist Home dedicated Grandview Annex, three apartments in a former bowling alley. Dr. Levi H. Zerr, Admin. Director.
- The celebration of the Jewish Festival of Tabernacles was held at the Beth Israel Synagogue with Howard S. Danzig, Director.
- The *Lebanon Daily News* conducted a brand new word game called BONANZAGRAM. Contestants filled out a form printed in the paper, pasted it on a 2-cent postcard, mailed it to the Editor, and hoped to win the first weekly prize of \$140. \$5.00 was added each week until there was a winner. However, the prize money had to be equally divided in the event of multiple winners.
